Call to Order

Chair Jim Urban called the meeting to order at 1:01 p.m. After introductions were made, it was determined that a quorum was present.

Review and Approval of Minutes

Hyun Lee, Clark County, made a motion to approve the minutes of the March 9 meeting (see April meeting packet). Matt Meunier, City of Jeffersontown, seconded the motion and it carried with a unanimous vote.

Public Comment Period

There were no public comments.

Transportation Policy Committee Report

Larry Chaney, KIPDA staff, reported on the March Transportation Policy Committee (TPC) meeting activities.

Transportation Planning Overview

Larry Chaney and Randy Simon, KIPDA staff, provided a presentation on how the quality of the air in our region (and its analysis) impacts transportation planning. There was discussion.

FY 2012 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP)

Larry Chaney, KIPDA staff, presented the Final Draft of the UPWP. At the time of the presentation, comments from the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet (KYTC) had not been received. There was discussion. **Matt Meunier, City of Jeffersontown, made a motion to recommend that the TPC approve the document pending an email review of KYTC's comments (once received) by the TTCC. Tom Clevidence, Town of Clarksville, seconded the motion, but withdrew his second to amend the language of the motion.**

Matt Meunier, City of Jeffersontown, made a motion to recommend that the TPC approve the document and that any comments or adjustments made to the UPWP after the TTCC meeting be presented to the TPC. Tom Clevidence, Town of Clarksville, seconded the motion, and it carried with a unanimous vote.

Horizon 2030 Long Range Plan Update

Mary Lou Hauber, KIPDA staff, presented a proposed amendment to the document (see April meeting packet). There was discussion. **Tom Clevidence, Town of Clarksville, made a motion to recommend approval of the amendment by the TPC and that any clarifications or administrative modifications (based on questions raised in the TTCC meeting) be made before TPC action. Brian Fogle, City of Jeffersonville, seconded the motion and it carried with a unanimous vote.**

FY 2011-2015 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)

Mary Lou Hauber, KIPDA staff, presented a proposed amendment to the document (see April meeting packet). There was discussion. **Hyun Lee, Clark County, made a motion to recommend approval of the amendment by the TPC and that any clarifications or administrative modifications (based on questions raised in the TTCC meeting) be made before TPC action. Dirk Gowin, Louisville Metro Public Works, seconded the motion and it carried with a unanimous vote.**

FY 2011-2015 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)

Mary Lou Hauber, KIPDA staff, presented administrative modifications to the short range funding document. No action was required.

Congestion Management Process (CMP) Update

Lori Kelsey, KIPDA staff, discussed the update currently underway and introduced foundation elements for committee review (see April meeting packet). There was discussion. **Dirk Gowin, Louisville Metro Public Works, made a motion to recommend that the TPC approve the three foundation elements so KIPDA staff may proceed with the CMP update. Matt Meunier, City of Jeffersontown, seconded the motion and it carried with a unanimous vote.**

Indiana Transportation Enhancement (TE) Priorities

Stacey Burton, KIPDA staff, presented the results of the TE priority process (see April meeting packet). **Tom Clevidence, Town of Clarksville, made a motion to recommend that the TPC approve the priorities as presented and submit them to the Indiana Department of Transportation (INDOT). Brian Fogle, City of Jeffersonville, seconded the motion and it carried with a unanimous vote.**

Other Business

Stacey Burton, KIPDA staff, announced that Safe Routes to School applications are due to INDOT by May 27.
