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The Unscheduled Project List (UPL) is a project list maintained by the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet Division of Planning that feeds projects into the KYTC Highway Plan; generally a document that specifies any state funding for projects over the next six years. The KYTC Highway Plan is updated every two years and submitted to the state legislature for approval. In turn, the UPL list is also updated every two years. The responsibility of submitting projects to the UPL falls to the ADDs in rural areas and the MPOs in urban areas. This priority process and UPL priority submission is for Bullitt, Jefferson, and Oldham counties.

On November 10, a working group consisting of representatives of Jeffersontown, the Kentucky Transportation District 5 Office, Louisville Metro, City of Shively, and Oldham County met to discuss project priorities for submission. The goal of the group was to identify priorities as prescribed by the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet, and present that list to the Transportation Policy Committee for approval (please see attached) prior to submission to the Transportation Cabinet. **The projects on the list are in no particular order; all of them are considered high priority projects for the region. Three specific projects were identified as having the highest priority over the others (I-265/Rehl Road Interchange; LaGrange Underpass; and, I-264 Manslick Road Interchange).**

Action is requested to approve the Project Priority list, and submit it to the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet as part of this UPL process.
